

Tajikistan Report on Presentation

Sunday the 13th of November "The Foundation for a Better Life" in Tajikistan conducted a big event in Dushanbe Serena Hotel's Social Hall. The participants were people from poor families who are unemployed, students from vulnerable families, and high school pupils.
